

Middle School Homework Policy

As a middle school staff we have a concise, consistent homework policy.

The core teachers (SS, LA, Science, Reading, Math and Religion) will record late or missing assignments on a daily basis. **A late assignment is one that is incomplete and/or turned in when the teacher asks for it.** When or if the student accumulates 3 late or missing assignments total, the student will be required to attend homework club (a \$6 fee per day) one day within a week of the last late assignment (1 hour minimum). A BLUE "invitation" form will be issued to the student alerting the parent. Parents are required to sign the form showing he/she is aware of the invitation. If student does not attend within the week an additional invitation will be issued (meaning 2 hours). If it becomes a problem with accumulated unserved invitations, the student will be required to serve an inschool suspension to complete all the missing work and fulfill the outstanding invitations.

If finances are a concern please discuss with Mr. Beisser and we can waive the fee.

Our goal is to promote student responsibility. We hope that this will diminish the amount of late or missing work for the kids and assist in helping them develop better work habits. If you have any questions, concerns, or comments please don't hesitate to contact one of us.
