



DRESS CODE POLICY

It is important to dress in a manner that is appropriate and shows respect for self and others in such a way that allows students to focus on the learning at hand. Here are the guidelines for the dress code policy at St. Dennis School:

4K – GRADE 3

- We understand the change in style for children and how hard it is to find longer shorts and skirts. Please remember to use discretion when purchasing school clothing.
- Hats may not be worn in school at any time. This includes after hours events. All clothes should be neat, clean, and in good shape (no holes).
- Shorts may be worn at any time. No child will be allowed to stay inside for recess due to wearing shorts in cold weather. Please use discretion when wearing shorts on cold days.
- Underwear should never be visible.
- Pants should be worn at appropriate height - no sagging.
- No inappropriate writing on any clothing (alcohol, gang, profanity, etc.).

GRADES 4 – 8

- Hats may not be worn in school at any time. This includes after hours events.
- All clothes should be neat, clean, and in good shape (no holes).
- Shorts may be worn at any time. No child will be allowed to stay inside for recess due to wearing shorts in cold weather. Please use discretion when wearing shorts on cold days.
- Shorts and skirts must be an appropriate length.
- Shirts should not be longer than your shorts. No midriff or tight-fitting shirts or sweaters.
- Underwear should never be visible.
- Pants should be worn at appropriate height - no sagging.
- No tube tops, muscle shirts, crop tops or apron back shirts.
- All necklines must go no lower than 2 inches below the clavicle.
- No inappropriate writing on any clothing (alcohol, gang, profanity, etc.).

FIELD TRIPS

Special guidelines will be determined by the teacher for each trip. Uniforms must be worn on all Wednesdays and field trip days.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

School polo shirt with tan/blue/black pants or skirt. If leggings are worn under a skirt, they must be a solid color with no writing on them. No joggers, sweatpants or basketball shorts allowed.

UNIFORM CONSEQUENCES

4K – GRADE 3: 1st, 2nd, 3rd time = Reminder; 4th time = Wear uniform for rest of the quarter.

GRADES 4 – 8: 1st time = Reminder; 2nd time = Wear uniform for rest of the year.

It is at the discretion of the principal at any time to request a child call his/her parent/guardian for a change of clothes.
