



Sponsor-A-Student Scholarship guidelines

- In order to receive assistance, an application must be on file in the school office by June 15th of the requesting school year.
- Applications must be made on an annual basis.
- Appropriate Federal Tax form 1040 must accompany the assistance application.
- Financial aid may be granted for up to a maximum of 50% of the regular tuition. Financial aid may not cover fees. Parish-member families are given priority consideration when scholarship funds are awarded.
- NO financial aid will be granted if current tuition account is not up to date from the previous year.
- Tuition assistance will be credited at the end of each semester only if agreed financial contract has been paid to date.
- Applying families must be in good standing with all school requirements. (Volunteer hours, behavior, finance, etc.)
