

Middle School Homework Policy

As a middle school staff, we have a concise, consistent homework policy.

The core teachers (SS, LA, Science, Reading, Math and Religion) will record late or missing assignments on a daily basis.

A **late assignment** is considered an assignment that WAS missing but has now been completed and graded.

A **missing assignment** is considered an assignment that has not been turned in.

- ~ The student will be given 1 additional day to turn in the missing work at no cost.
- ~ After 1 additional day, the highest score a student can receive on an assignment is a 92%.
- ~ Any work submitted from day 3 to day 7 will be graded and rewarded up to 75%.
- ~ Any work submitted after the 1 week extension will be scored as a 0% and no credit given.

When or if the student accumulates 3 **missing assignments** total in a quarter, the student will be required to miss their Tuesday/Thursday electives (not including Spanish). They may not return to their electives until the following occurs.

- ~ all missing assignments are turned in
- ~ the missing assignments are finished completely
- ~ the missing assignments are completed to a grade of over 70%

An email will be issued to alert the parent that 3 or more missing assignments have accumulated and that the student will not be attending electives.

Our goal is to promote student responsibility. We hope that this will diminish the amount of late or missing work for the kids and assist in helping them develop better work habits.
